	After attending informational workshop the district applied to SERC for training and technical support to begin implementation of PBIS in each high school beginning in September 2013.	
	Both high schools were chosen by SERC to begin training in the implementation of PBIS beginning in the September 2013.	
	Each high school has developed a school-wide behavioral leadership team	
	A district wide PBIS roll-out plan to begin in the fall 2013 starting at the two high schools and introducing two additional schools each year has been developed.
