

Use of Tobacco/Substitute Devices

The Board of Education is concerned with maintaining a safe and healthy working and learning environment for all staff and students. Medical research has established that smoking and using other tobacco products are hazardous to one's health.

Therefore, smoking or other use of tobacco products including smokeless tobacco or substitute devices (e.g., electronic cigarettes) is prohibited in school buildings and on school grounds at all times.
