 - Bid specifications have been put together, proposal was opened by RedFlex, 3 year contract, can extend contract for 2 more years, town will receive 28%, town is reviewing contract language, have installed 15 temporary cameras to analyze routes and determine high risk areas, will install 5 cameras on vehicles and will communicate with Wallingford Police Department, hoping to roll program out first or second week in October, press release will be created, information will be posted on the website
 - Question was asked if RedFlex can terminate the contract. Linda Winters will explore.
 - Where does the 28% go? It goes to the town budget, not the BOE budget.
 - Information was already presented to the bus drivers, who were in favor of the program.

 - Reviewed the NGSS, current standards are 10 years old, goal is to better prepare students for STEM careers, less memorization of facts and more application of knowledge and skills, more relevant to students and more practice-based, will take a great deal of teacher training

 - High school used Nutmeg list exclusively
 - Summer reading committee will meet throughout the school year
 - Question- what is the objective for summer reading? Pick a book and read for some, some AP courses require summer reading, used to lose points for not participating, now extra credit is given for summer reading
