

Board Organizational Meeting

At the organizational meeting of the Board of Education, which is to be held in January of even numbered years, the Board of Education shall elect, by open and recorded vote of each member, from its membership, a chairperson, a vice-chairperson, and a secretary. This meeting shall be called to order by the senior member of the Board present (seniority based on terms of total years of service on the school board.)

Should the office of chairperson, vice-chairperson, or secretary become vacant between organizational meetings, the board shall hold an election to fill the vacated office. The officer shall be nominated and elected through the same methods as used at the organizational meeting and which are described in the previous paragraph.

The agenda of this organizational meeting may include such other items of business deemed appropriate.
