

Board Committees

The Board recognizes that the principles of sound Board procedure are best served when the Board functions as a committee of the whole. In order to expedite such smooth functioning, the Board authorizes the establishment of such standing and/or temporary committees as it finds necessary to study operations in specific areas and to make recommendations for Board policy and action.

1. Standing Committees

- a. Standing committees and their chairpersons shall be appointed biennially by Board chairperson at the first regular meeting following the organizational meeting. The Board has authorized the following standing committees: **Instructional, Operations, Board-Council Liaison and Board/PTO Council Liaison Committee** which shall meet on a regularly scheduled basis.
- b. The Board also authorizes the Education Council as a standing committee which shall meet when there is a determined need.

2. Temporary Committees

The chairperson shall appoint such temporary and special committees as may be deemed necessary or advisable by the Board of Education and the Chairperson shall serve ex officio as a member of each committee. The duties of the committee shall be outlined at the time of appointment and the committee shall be considered dissolved when its final report has been made.

3. The Board of Education shall act as a committee of the whole in final consideration of all matters.
