

Board Member Compensation, Expenses, and Insurance

Board members shall receive no compensation for their services. However, upon submitting vouchers and supporting bills for expenses incurred in carrying out specific services previously authorized by the Board, Board members may be reimbursed from district funds.

Board members are protected from financial loss and expenses, including legal fees, arising out of any claim or judgement by reason of negligence resulting in bodily injury, property damage, or infringement of any person's civil rights. Such indemnification applies only if the Board member's acts were not wanton, reckless, or malicious, and if the member was acting within the scope of his or her duties.

The Board may insure itself against any potential liability imposed upon it.
