

**School Building Administration (Principals)**

Acting with the approval of the superintendent and upon the advice of the central office administrators, each principal will be the chief administrator of his school. All personnel assigned to the building will be directly responsible to the principal. Staff members who work in more than one school will be responsible to the principal of the school during the time they are working in the building.

The principal is charged with the supervision, direction and safety of the staff and the students assigned to the building and with the care of the school facility and its equipment. The principal also must monitor the teaching staff to ensure that they are teaching to the district curriculum and monitor staff compliance with the policies, rules, and regulations of the district and the directives of district administration. Within the framework of the policies of the Board of Education and the general rules and regulations set by the superintendent, the principal may establish and enforce such additional regulations as he/she deems advisable for the efficient operation of the school.
