

**Income from Vocational Education Sales And Services**

The services and products provided through the district's various vocational programs are not designed to be competitive with local businesses nor to produce revenue for the district. When such services and/or products are made available to the public, the customer will be charged an amount sufficient to cover costs of materials, supplies, and any parts used. Charges, except for reimbursement for materials and parts, will be waived for students enrolled in the course and nonprofit organizations.

Money received from customers will be turned in to the school comptroller for deposit in the appropriate student activity account. The revenue will go into a special account set up to cover parts, materials, and miscellaneous costs for the services provided in these programs.
