

Student Transportation Services

The Board of Education shall provide transportation for pupils in compliance with the provisions of state law and regulations. The Superintendent of Schools or designee shall administer the operation of transportation to:

1. Provide for maximum safety of pupils.
2. Supplement and reinforce desirable pupil behavior.
3. Assist handicapped pupils appropriately.
4. Enrich the instructional program through carefully planned field trips as recommended by staff.

Transportation by private carrier may be provided whenever such practice is more economical than that purchased via contracted services for all public school children.

Parents may be reimbursed for transportation only under those special circumstances as approved by the Superintendent acting on behalf of the Board of Education.
