

Professional Staff Time Schedules

The Board of Education has a legal responsibility for establishing school calendars. The Board will also establish daily time schedules for students and staff that meet both the needs of the students and State of Connecticut mandates. Schedules for students will be announced annually by the superintendent in his newsletter to staff and in the local news media for parents and students.

In accordance with recognition by the Wallingford Education Association and as a continuing practice, teachers will be in their classrooms a minimum of 20 minutes before the start of the student school day and remain 20 minutes after the student school day, unless they are required to arrive earlier or remain later than the 20 minute minimum for such activities as described in the current teachers' contract and as directed by the administration.

The time before and after school, when not used for specific assignments by the administration, shall be used in accordance with provisions of the current teachers' contract.
