

Programs for Gifted and Talented Students

The Wallingford Public Schools strive to meet the needs of all students including those students who possess outstanding academic gifts and/or artistic talents. Thus, the district will maintain gifted and talented programs which are based on the premise that high potential students deserve special opportunities to enhance and develop their gifts and/or talents.

Therefore, the superintendent of schools shall ensure that:

- Written procedures are in place for the identification of academically gifted and artistically talented students, and
- Programs for the gifted and talented are offered to students, subject to approval by the board of education.
