

**Summer School**

I. **WALLINGFORD PUBLIC SCHOOLS** may operate a financially self-sustaining program of review courses and enrichment activities during the summer. The Director of Summer Programs shall make the determination as to which courses and activities have sufficient enrollments to be run. All offerings in the summer program must be consistent with district's learning goals.

A. **Types of Offerings**: The summer school program may include the following opportunities:

1. Review courses for students who have failed or for which they have lost credit in the regular school year.
2. Review courses for students to strengthen their academic foundation in preparation for more advanced course work in the regular school year.
3. Enrichment activities on a noncredit basis.

B. **Attendance** at summer school programs will be voluntary.

C. **Transportation** will be the responsibility of the parents/guardians.

II. **OTHER SUMMER PROGRAMS**: Students may remediate courses they have failed or for which they have lost credit in summer programs offered at other accredited schools with advance written approval from the building administration.
