

**Adult Education**

**I. STATEMENT OF BELIEFS** - Education is a continuing, life-long learning process. Therefore, it is the policy of the Board of Education to provide a strong adult education program that will enable adults to:

1. Acquire the basic skills necessary to function as productive and responsible citizens.
2. Continue their education to a level equivalent to that of completion of high school.
3. Secure training that will enable them to become more employable.

**II. REQUIRED PROGRAMS OF INSTRUCTION** - By law, the Board of Education must provide programs at no charge for:

1. Americanization and United States citizenship,
2. English for adults with limited English proficiency, and
3. Secondary school completion.
