

Scheduling High School Courses

The Board of Education will make every effort to allow a student at the high school level who has begun a sequence or series of courses in a subject area to complete that sequence or series. However, the Board of Education reserves the right to:

1. Make necessary program revisions and to cancel any class with insufficient enrollment.
2. Limit sequential or series opportunities in a subject area to only two years.
3. Schedule two courses in the same subject area within one section.
4. Schedule combinations of differing levels of the same course within one section provided that the students are informed in writing of the expectations for the level in which they are enrolled.
5. Offer sequential or series opportunities in a subject area at only one high school, not at both.
