

Requests for Reconsideration of an Instructional Material

The Wallingford Board of Education is legally responsible for all matters relating to the operation of the school district. While the Board of Education upholds the right of all parents to assess and evaluate their own children's educational materials, it will resist any attempt to censor materials used by others.

Requests for reconsideration of instructional materials shall be carefully investigated, but it must be recognized that the ultimate responsibility for selection of educational materials rests with school authorities.
