

**Admission of Interdistrict Transfer Students**

The following regulations pertain to Wallingford students who wish to attend local schools out of their residence district.

1. **FAMILY MOVE:** Whenever the family of a student, grades K - 12, moves from one residence district to another, he/she will have the right to continue at the original school until the completion of the present school year. If a family moves to either of the two high school districts after the beginning of a student's junior or senior year, then the student will be allowed to complete his/her high school program at the original school. In all instances, no transportation will be provided by the school district.
2. **PROGRAM OPTION:** Students are authorized to transfer to the high school out of their residence district if it offers a curricular program not found at their assigned high school. Such transfer may occur only in the year that the students will actually be enrolled in the program. Following completion or termination of the program by the students in any year other than their senior year, the students must return to their residence district high school. Transportation is provided at district expense for program transfers.
3. **SPECIAL REQUEST:** A parent or guardian may request that their child be allowed to transfer to another school in the district because extenuating circumstances would make such a transfer be in the best interest of the child's welfare. Such request must be made in writing to the superintendent of schools who will confer with the principal of the school involved before rendering a decision on the request. No transportation will be provided at district expense for such requests.

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
