

Student Conduct on School Transportation**PROCEDURES FOR ENFORCEMENT OF REGULATIONS**

1. The bus driver shall notify the child if the child is in violation of bus regulations or if the child's conduct is inappropriate. The driver shall file a report with the school principal if the student fails to respond to requests for cooperation.
2. The principal, in turn, shall notify the parent/guardian of the action taken by the bus driver. The child and parent/guardian will be advised that repeated misbehavior will result in the denial of transportation.
3. Should such misbehavior persist further, the student shall be denied the privilege of bus transportation. Guidelines for suspension from bus privileges shall be congruent to those for suspension from school (see policy JGD).
4. The parents/guardians of any student who willfully damages a bus and/or the equipment thereof shall be held financially responsible for the cost of repairs. The bus privilege may be suspended until the full payment is made for the required repairs.
5. The total length of time during which a student may be denied bus transportation may not exceed fifty (50) schools days in any given school year.
