

Student Use of Automobiles

I. PARKING PRIVILEGES: Students who are licensed drivers may be allowed parking privileges in a designated area of the school parking lot. Parking permission may be revoked for any violation of an established school parking or driving rule, including, but not limited to:

1. Driving at an excessive speed on school grounds.
2. Reckless or dangerous driving on school grounds.
3. Failing to park in an area designated for students.
4. Leaving the school grounds without permission.
5. Violation of any traffic law on school grounds.
6. Visiting the automobiles during the school day without permission of a building administrator.

II. DRIVING TO FIELD TRIPS: Students may not drive vehicles to or from field trips.

III. DRIVING TO MEETINGS OR EVENTS

When the school authorizes students to attend meetings or events off school grounds, transportation will be provided by the school. If a student requests permission to transport himself/herself to or from a meeting or event, the principal must receive advance written permission from the parent or guardian. Under no circumstances may a student provide such transportation for any other student.
