Use of School Equipment

Non-profit organizations, e.g. Boy Scouts, Junior Women's Club, Rotary, etc., are eligible to borrow Wallingford Public Schools equipment under the following provisions:

1. The borrowing of equipment of the Wallingford Public Schools shall be at the discretion of the Superintendent of Schools or his designee.
2. The time duration for any equipment borrowed shall be clearly specified.
3. It is recognized that school needs shall always have first priority over the requests of any non-school user.
4. Any borrower of school equipment shall be solely responsible for the equipment while in his control. Any borrower shall immediately reimburse the Board of Education for loss or damage to any equipment borrowed whether caused by him or any third person while the equipment is under his control.
5. Any borrower shall sign such documents as may be required by the Superintendent of Schools to save the Board of Education harmless for any injury caused to any person or to any property by any equipment borrowed regardless of the user of such equipment.
6. Borrowers shall have the responsibility of picking up and returning equipment.
