Relations with Non-School Groups

The Wallingford Board of Education welcomes the assistance of all non-school groups who seek to enhance the educational program. All such assistance, however, must be consistent with Board of Education policies, instruction objectives, and programs. The administration, therefore, is charged with the responsibility of accepting only those offers of assistance which meet this criterion.

The Board of Education also charges the administration with the responsibility of monitoring the activities of those groups whose assistance is accepted. These activities must meet the criterion of being consistent with Board policies, instruction objectives, and programs.

It is the Board of Education's expectation that most offers of assistance from non-school groups will be addressed by the administration. The administration, however, may refer to the Board any offers which the administration deems to be of such a nature that they should be reviewed by the Board before being accepted. Conversely the Board reserves the prerogative of reviewing any offers that is deems to be of such a nature that Board review is required.
