## HOW DO I FIND A BOOK TO DOWNLOAD?

- 1) Go to [destiny.wallingford.k12.ct.us](http://destiny.wallingford.k12.ct.us) in any browser.
- 2) Select Lyman Hall High School
- 3) Search for books by keyword, title, or author.
- 4) Look for the following symbols in the return list:
- 5) This symbol means the book can be borrowed and read online: 
- 6) This symbol means the book can be borrowed and listened to online: 
- 7) Log-in to Destiny in the upper right corner using your WPS computer log-in information.
- 8) Select OPEN to borrow the e-book.
- 9) Select BORROW to check the book out.
- 10) Go to your Checkouts page to read the book in your browser or to download the book to your device to be read with the *Overdrive App*.
