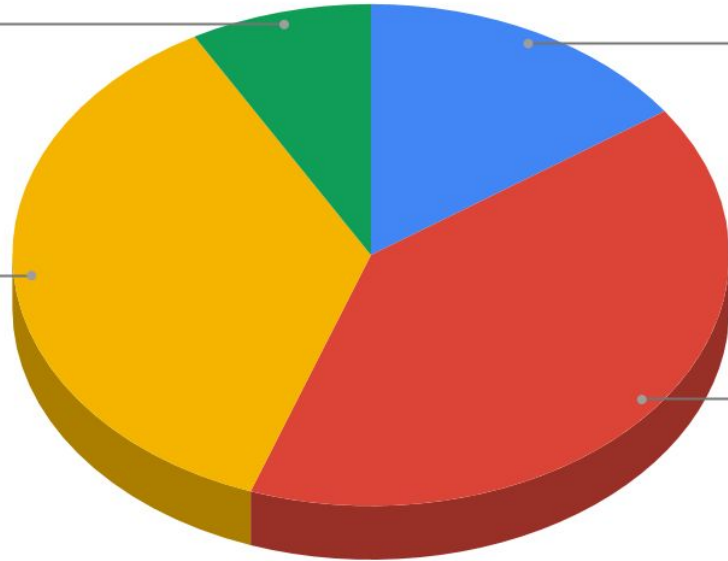

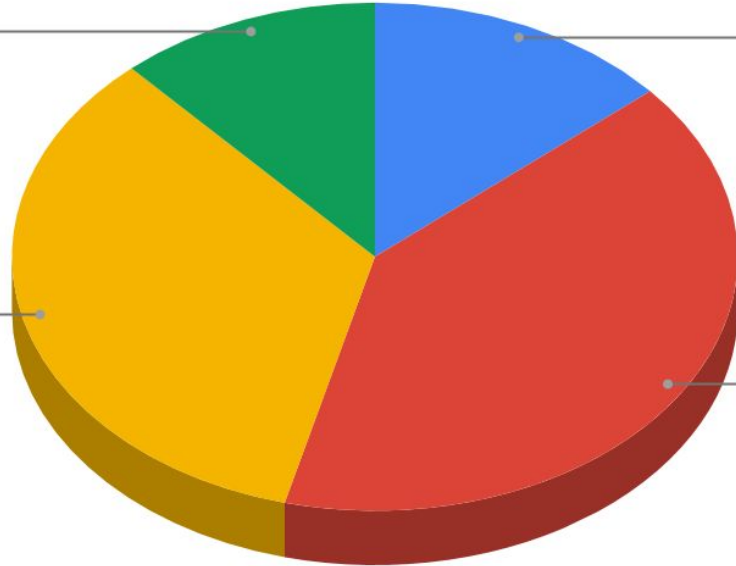

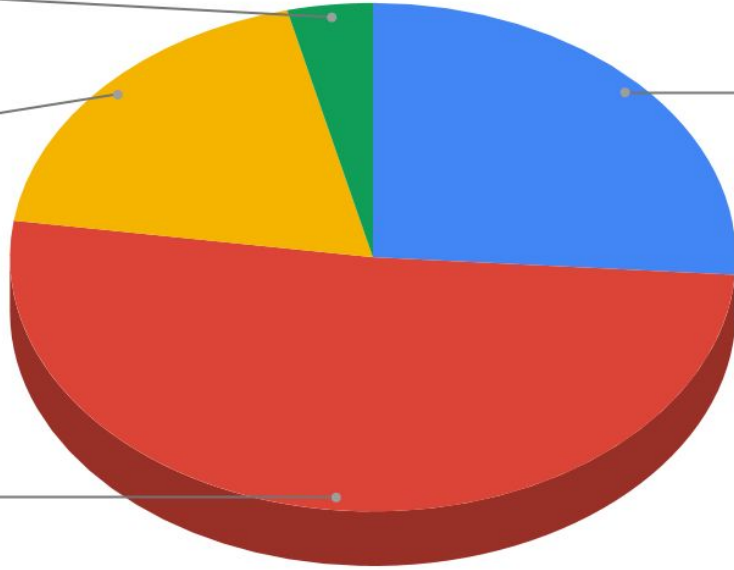

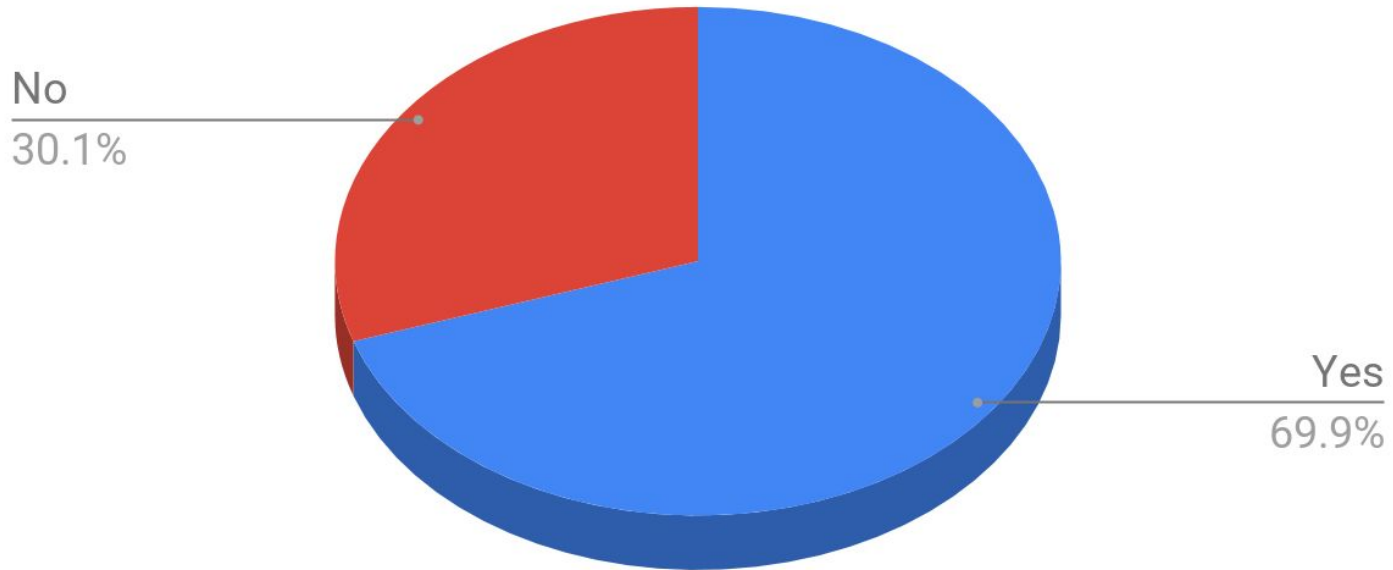

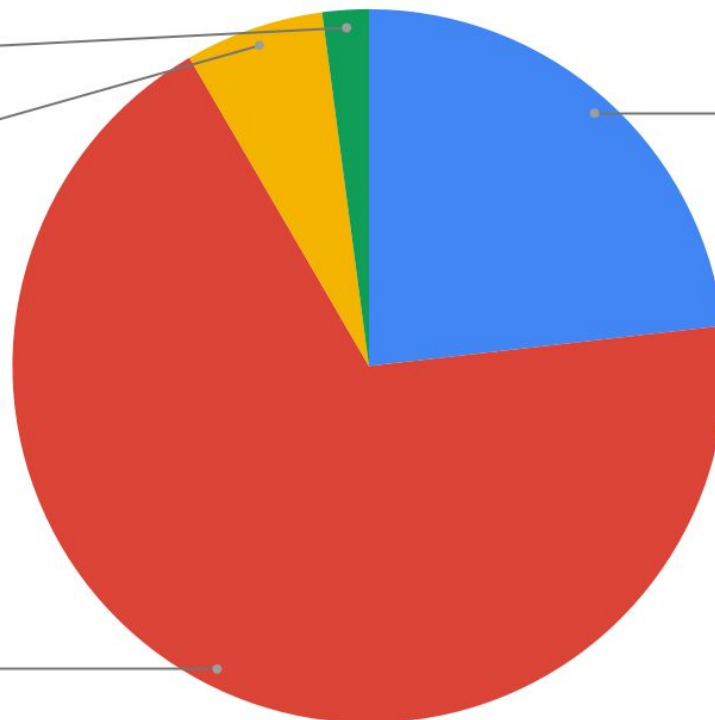

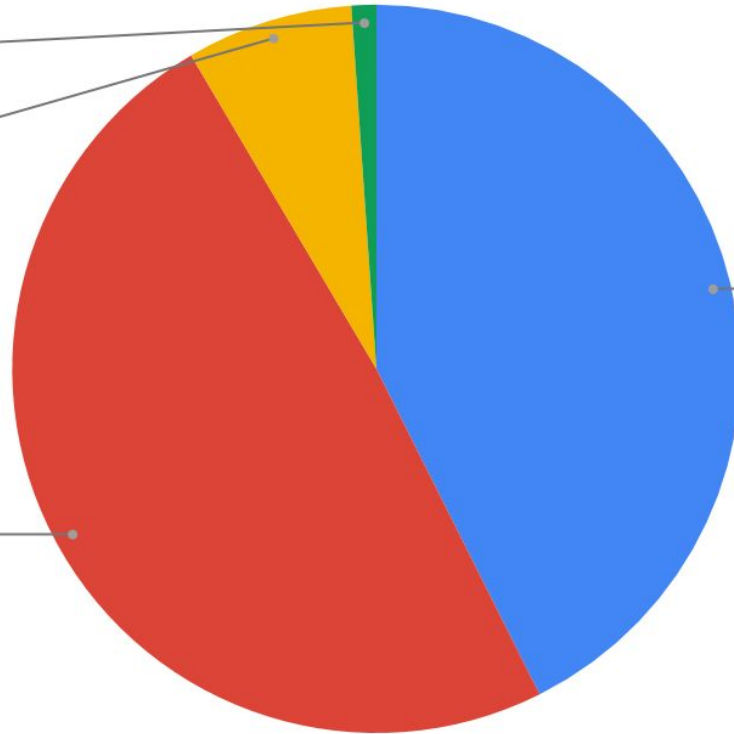

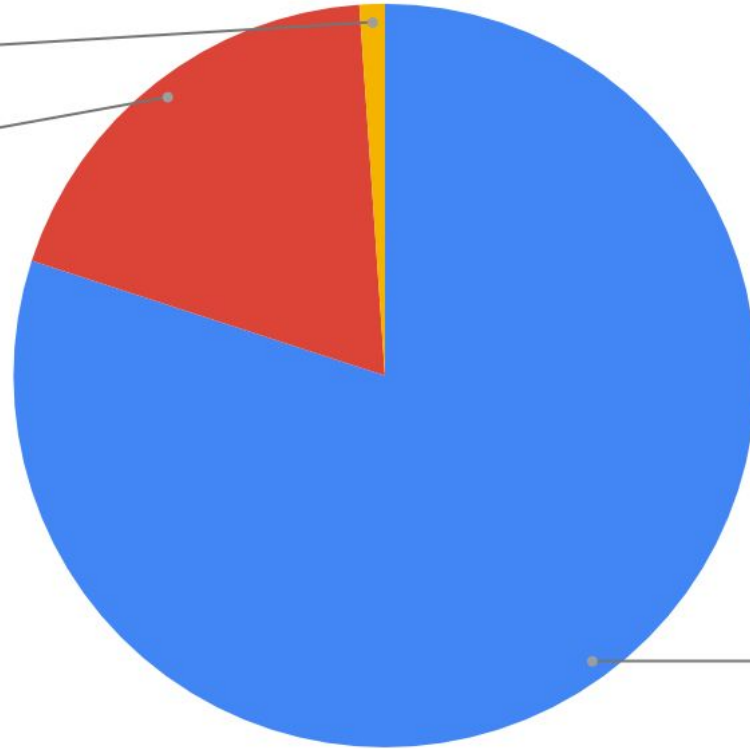
I Feel There are Trusted Adults at Moran Whom My Child Can Go/Talk to for Help

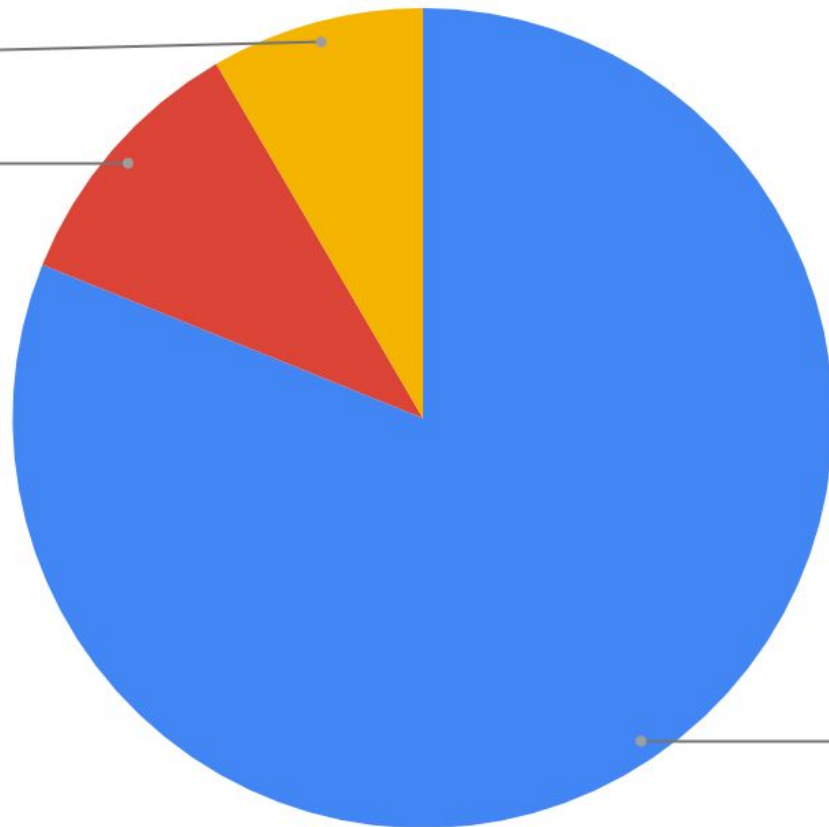

Area of Focus this Year:

The district climate committee would like schools to have one main focus for the year in regards to their survey data; this question was ours. On the first day of school we had PD with teachers to share this data and to emphasize how important this statement is.

We used the number 3,864, which is the number of times a middle school student will walk into an adults room during their 3 years here, so there are that many opportunities to build trust with our students.

The parent response for the same question had 20% of parents answering either "no" or "not sure"

There is a trusted adult in this school whom I can go to for help:

37.1% of students responded "No" (10.1%) or "Sure" (27%)
